**JUST FAITH** founder, Jack Jezreel, Returns to Laramie, Tuesday January 31<sup>st</sup>.

Jack Jezreel, the executive director and founder of JustFaith Ministries, is making a return visit to Laramie on Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup> to present a free lecture on "Jesus and the Call to Abundant Life: Living Well and Just." As the Gospels beckon us to a way of being and living in the world that is socially critical, spiritually robust, and personally satisfying, Mr. Jezreel will pose the question, "While living in a world of distractions and suffering, what might the Catholic faith offer in the way of inspiration, hope and possibility? And what are the implications for the future of the Church--and each of us--as we consider the human and global challenges ahead.

JustFaith is a transforming entity that crafts faith formation programs emphasizing the Gospel message of peace and justice, Church social teaching and the intersection of spirituality and action.

Jezreel knows that justice work never ends and continues to develop new programs to reach more people and parishes. January's presentation will be held in the University Union Yellowstone room at 7:00 pm.
