Jack Jezreel, the executive director and founder of JustFaith Ministries, is making a return visit to Laramie on Tuesday, January 31st to present a free lecture on "Jesus and the Call to Abundant Life: Living Well and Just." Jezreel knows that justice work never ends and continues to develop new programs to reach more people and parishes. January's presentation will be held in the University Union Yellowstone room at 7:00 pm.
