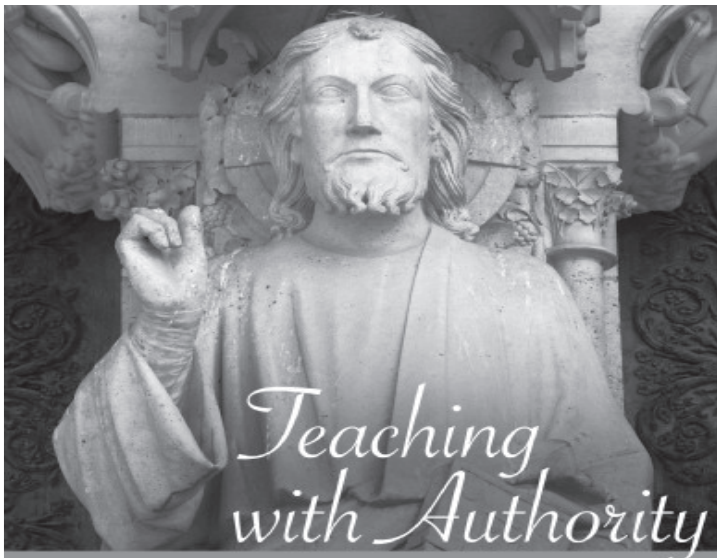

“Looking for adventure? Looking for fulfillment?” You will find both travelling with us to ZAMBIA, Africa in June, 2012. We will visit the Muzeyi Rural Health Clinic run by the Sisters of Ottawa in Kalichero, Zambia. Staying with the Sisters at the Our Lady of Peace convent, we will work in their Clinic as they see an average of 200 patients a day who have walked or bicycled for miles from their homes. Daily routines include Pregnant Mother Checkups, Baby Immunizations, HIV Testing and Checkups, and Nutrition Classes. Last year we were blessed with the birth of two babies - who were subsequently named after the volunteers assisting their mothers!! We will accompany the midwife and nurses on their Outreach Visits as they travel many miles to the outskirts of the country carrying immunizations to babies far away from Kalichero. You will be delighted to attend Drama Presentations in rural villages as actors explain disease prevention and treatments through song and dance. This year marks the Silver Anniversary of Muzeyi, so we will be attending celebrations throughout our trip. Volunteers throughout Wyoming, including Father Carr and Father Lucas, have been blessed by our three trips to Zambia. Talk to them. Be inspired by them. Come with us in 2012. Just Peacemaking Initiative: The Challenge and Promise of Nonviolence for Our Time.

St. Anthony's, JustFaith and Pax Christi are offering a module created as a resource for small groups to deepen their understanding and practice of peacemaking. At the core of the module is the intentional building of relationships at every level of society. Relationships that are dedicated to

- nonviolent transformation of conflict,
- the pursuit of social justice, and
- the creation of cultures of sustainable peace.

The module, starting in February, will explore the challenges and promises of justice-based peacemaking through a series of 12 sessions, combining prayer and ritual, readings and discussion, a strong spirit of group dialog and interaction, and immersion activities based on local resources.
